# Clir Felicity Cunliffe-Lister Parish Report Clint: January 25

### **Highways**

I have been in correspondence with the Chair concerning progress with the VAS sign. I will allocate £1K of this year's Locality Budget towards the cost of the purchase, with a view to in being installed in the following financial year – subject to the speed limit reduction being first put in place.

### **Waste Collection**

With the current snowy conditions, collections have been interrupted. Operators will try to return to missed properties once conditions improve.

### Connectivity

I am still waiting on the public announcement for the Gigabit delivery, to establish which dwellings are scheduled to be connected, and I have chased the NYC on this. The response received is that they have not yet seen any detail, residents can email <a href="mailto:enquiries@dsit.gov.uk">enquiries@dsit.gov.uk</a> to ask for this as and when it is in circulation.

I have also emailed smartdcc about the issues with the radio signal required for smart meters to work in the area and asked why mobile phone signal can't be used (which is the case in southern counties).

## **Community Partnership**

I have a steering group meeting next week, to establish the task and finish groups that will focus on the key issues (housing, connectivity, transport etc)

## **Home to School Transport**

I would like to know if there are families in the parish with 16-18yr age children in education who do not have access to transport to school. My understanding was that the school buses serving the 11-16yr group could not allow the older age group to pay for a seat, due to compliance issues. This may not be the case, so I might be able to help with this.

# **Planning**

I am aware of enforcement action being taken regarding the demolition of a dwelling at Oakfield, Clint Bank.

David Skaith, the Mayor for York and North Yorkshire, is asking for the public's views before he sets the amount that goes to North Yorkshire Police and North Yorkshire Fire and Rescue Service from York and North Yorkshire's council tax bill. ### **Locality Budget**

### **Boundary Commission**

The Boundary Commission has launched a public consultation to help shape new council divisions, which would come into being at the 2027 elections. This follows the submission of a proposal for 89 single-member divisions from NYC, which was approved by Full Council on 24 July. The Boundary Commission has accepted this number and will now consider suitable division boundaries. The two key considerations are electoral equality (meaning divisions with a broadly equal number of electors) and that divisions reflect local communities and identities.

The Council's Tory majority Boundary Review Member Working Group presented a recommended model of divisions, which has been approved by the Executive and submitted to the Boundary Commission on behalf of North Yorkshire Council. This is a large document, but at p183 is the relevant section showing which parishes are falling into which ward (see p212) and a not very clear map at p197. Clint - at p214 – is listed as falling within a new Nidderdale division and not Masham & Fountains. The old Nidderdale division has been replaced by a very much bigger Wharfedale (in my view too big) which includes Pateley Bridge. The LibDem submission reinstates the old Nidderdale division, with Clint falling within it. The Boundary Commission will next issue their draft proposals for consultation 1st April – 9th June.
