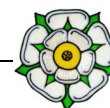

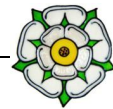

2026.131	<p>Matters arising from previous meetings (Items requested to remain on the agenda or to be resolved)</p> <p>a) AM to update the council on playground matters Ongoing: AM has applied for National Lottery & Nidderdale Community Fund grants, their responses are due in May. -The council received a lovely email from a school pupil asking for the playground to be improved. AM has responded. -GW, RP and AM are to do some tidying in the meantime, removing the broken fencing and installing a new gate.</p> <p>b) GW to update the council on the updates to the Cricket Club wall & asbestos removal Ongoing: Materials have been removed, many thanks to the Cricket Club. Now awaiting a response about the wall rebuild.</p> <p>c) GW/RP to update the council on the school flagpole Resolved: School have decided not to replace the flagpole</p> <p>d) GW to update on Village Gates & funding Ongoing: Funding has been withdrawn due to a location issue. Highways have approved the locations, GW will pursue a quote from approved contractors for furniture & installation.</p> <p>e) GW to update on the VAS sign & funding Ongoing: Signpost due to be installed in March. Awaiting installation before purchasing sign. Speedlines on the hill are monitoring the effects of the new 40mph limit. GW to push for a fixed speed camera.</p> <p>f) GW to update on Community Speed Watch Scheme Ongoing: GW updated that there were no further developments on this and that he would follow up.</p> <p>g) GW to update on Clint Bank Lane Potholes and Highways communications, including the kerb outside the New Inn Deferred: Some potholes have been filled on Clint Bank Lane. The New Inn kerb is not in this year's budget; try for 27/28. MoP flagged that there is a very large deep pothole on Law Lane. - a) For the Council to consider the replacement of the Cricket Club Defibrillator
Deferred: GW advised the defibrillator will soon be obsolete; budget will need to be set aside from 26/27. Pye Lane defibrillator will also need a new battery next year, about £200. RP suggested there may be a grant that would help. **GW**
 - b) MoP raised an issue with spiky thorns and offcuts which had been left after hedge cutting and were dangerous to both walkers and dogs.
Ongoing: AM to chat with the land owner and politely request for them to be swept up after future hedge cutting. **AM**
 - c) MoP informed of blocked gulleys in Bedlam that had been overflowing and caused a potential ice/skid risk in winter.
Resolved: MoP has been in touch with NYC himself; they have since cleared 5 gulleys. The council passed on its thanks. ✓
 - d) MoP informed of noise issues to do with a barking dog affecting several properties.
