2026.003	Annual Report by Geoff Walker, Chair of Clint Cum Hamlets Parish Council _ Cllr Walker affirmed that the appointment of the new clerk in January 2026 had proven a highly positive development for the council _ The 40mph speed limit reduction through the village was an achievement to get in place in November 2025, however many are still speeding. Building positive relationships with NY Police and Highways has been helpful, but there is still a lot to do. There are several plans to improve this throughout 26/27. _ Disappointing not to get the National Lottery grant for the playground but the council will keep trying to find funding & make improvements in the meantime _ Cllr Walker passed on his thanks and appreciation to all the councillors for their work, time and support _ Overall, Cllr Walker said it had been a fantastic year and he hopes that the Parish Council will get a lot of positive things done in the year to come.
2026.004	Financial Report by N. Titchmarsh, Parish Clerk & RFO _ NT reported that it seems to have been a relatively quiet year financially, leaving the Parish Council in a positive position to start 26/27. _ There were complications with the Year End and HMRC which have skewed our receipt & payment figures, but all is as it should be financially. _ We have a clean bill of health from the Internal Auditor, apart from lacking an IT Policy, a new requirement, which is in hand. We're ready for Annual Governance Reporting. 25/26 financial documents will soon be posted online.
